



Master Juan Camargo Huaman comes from the Quechua tradition and is the founder of the project „PAQARINA“. He studied with different masters in the Andes and worked in his youth many years as a healer and shaman. For many years he gave teachings in various countries of the earth to pass on the spiritual path of the tradition of the Earth.

In recent years, he has devoted himself more and more to the project PAQARINA, the first spiritual center of the Andean tradition since the Conquista, where the ancient knowledge of the Incas is gathered. PAQARINA means „place of rebirth“ and considers itself as a school for children and adults (in their search for the truth).

Here, education is understood holistically, in the sense of an integration of nature and science with the ancestral knowledge of the ancients and the promotion of relationships based on human values. In PAQARINA, the spiritual path of the earth is lived, learned and taught. We consciously integrate ourselves into the rhythm of nature, celebrate the feasts of the seasons and use the powers of nature to recognize our own inner nature and to harmonize with nature.

The heart of the project is the preservation and dissemination of all aspects of Andean culture, as well as the sustainable promotion of social and ecological living in the immediate area. The project shall have an integrating effect on the entire region, as the population is invited to continue their education and to participate.

What has been implemented so far:

- Preparation of the land
- The containment of the property with stone and clay walls (traditional handicraft)
- start of the construction of the irrigation system; construction of the water channels; there are still missing cisterns and wells
- Construction of a small kitchen, a small dining room and a simple room for temporary staff from Europe
- A house with four rooms with bathroom for the permanent staff from Europe
- Living space for the project director with library and reception room
- A 180 m2 greenhouse with drip irrigation (the interior is missing)
- Planting of the first fruit trees



Goals of the project:

- Lived connection of nature, science, culture, philosophy and spirituality
- Schools for children and adults in search of themselves, where both traditional knowledge and modern knowledge are taught to create a future where man learns to live in harmony with the earth and all of its nature
- Integration and education of women in the area
- Sustainable organic agriculture based on the traditional knowledge of the Incas
- Research and recovery of traditional healing methods and the deep knowledge about the healing powers of all things in nature
- Preservation and revival of all aspects of Andean art (dance, theater, weaving, pottery etc.)
- Preservation and transmission of the original languages of the Andes (Quechua, Aymara, Queros)
- Celebration of the traditional ceremonies and teaching of the spiritual knowledge of the Incas

What does the initiative 1000x100 include?

- Continuation of the perimeter wall and design of the main entrance
- Expansion of the water channels, cisterns and wells
- Construction of toilets, showers and sleeping facilities for lectures
- Premises for events
- Expansion of the garden and agricultural production
- Acquisition of simple machines for soil cultivation
